She is a member of the American Psychological Association and the International Association of Behavior Analysis, and serves on the Board of Trustees of the Cambridge Center for Behavioral Studies.

Prior to earning a doctorate degree in clinical psychology from WVU, Lattal graduated with Honors from Johns Hopkins University, and received both a master's and bachelor's degree from the University of Alabama, respectively.
